hence this has resulted in the change in the paradigm in the education sector.

Classes are being taken online and students have adapted a new way of learning by

using their smartphones, laptops and desktops.

The Resource Person has given the links on Open Access e- Resources that provide

learning materials for both students and teachers, which can be downloaded. They

can search and browse by author, title, subject, language and more.

The workshop concludes with a vote of thanks from Ms. S. Kharkamni, Librarian of

the college.

This workshop has enlightened the students and teachers on the various open

access e-resources which they can access for their academic purposes. the

resource person has also shared the links of the various open access e-resources
