WHAT IS CUET - 2022?

CUET IS A TEST DESIGN TO PROVIDE A SINGLE WINDOW OPPORTUNITY TO STUDENTS TO SEEK ADMISSION IN DIFFERENT PROGRAMMES OF THE PARTICIPATING 45 CENTRAL UNIVERSITIES ACROSS THE COUNTRY.



WHO CAN TAKE PART?

ALL ASPIRING STUDENTS SEEKING ADMISSION INTO VARIOUS UNDER GRADUATE COURSES

MUST HAVE CLEARED THE PLUS TWO LEVEL (CLASS-12) OR ARE APPEARING PLUS TWO LEVEL EDUCATION IN 2022

CANDIDATES WHO FAILED IN ONE OR TWO SUBJECTS OF CLASS 12TH WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR CUET 2022



WHO IS EXECUTING THIS TEST?

THE NATIONAL TESTING AGENCY (NTA) HAS BEEN ASSIGNED THE TASK OF CONDUCTING THE CUET – 2022.

Role of NTA:

The Role of NTA is confined to registration of candidates, conduct of the test, hosting of answer key, inviting challenges, finalising answer keys, preparing and declaring result and hosting Score Card.

Merit list will be prepared by participating Universities/ organisations. Universities may conduct their individual counselling on the basis of the score card of CUET (UG)-2022 provided by NTA.



BASICS OF CUET

- ► THE TEST WILL BE CONDUCTED IN 13 LANGUAGES.
- THE TEST IS MANDATORY FOR ALL CENTRAL UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES THAT ARE AFFILIATED TO THEM.
- STATE / PRIVATE / DEEMED TO BE UNIVERSITIES ARE ALSO ENCOURAGED TO TAKE PART IN THE CUET – 2022.
- CUET (UG) 2022 WILL BE CONDUCTED IN COMPUTER BASED TEST (CBT) MODE.
- OBJECTIVE TYPE MULTIPLE CHOICE QUESTIONS (MCQS).
- ASPIRING CANDIDATES ARE REQUIRED TO REGISTER AND APPLY ONLINE BEFORE TAKING THE TEST.



HOW TO APPLY?

- CLICK ON THE REGISTER BUTTON AT THE BOTTOM OF THE PAGE.
- ENTER THE REQUISITE DETAILS ON THE REGISTRATION FORM AND REGISTER
- NOTE DOWN CAREFULLY YOUR APPLICATION NUMBER AND PASSWORD.
- FILL THE APPLICATION FORM AND PROVIDE ALL THE REQUIRED DETAILS (PERSONAL, EXAMINATION AND OTHER DETAILS).
- UPLOAD PASSPORT SIZE PHOTOGRAPH WITH 80% FACE WITHOUT MASK (SIZE: 10 KB to 200 KB; File Type: Jpeg/Jpg)
- UPLOAD DIGITAL SIGNATURE (SIZE: 4 KB to 30 KB; File Type: Jpeg/Jpg)
- UPLOAD SC/ST/OBC CERTIFICATE (SIZE: 50 KB to 300KB; File Type: pdf)
- PAY THE FEES

Section IA – 13 Languages: (Medium of Test)

Tamil, Telegu, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Gujarati, Odiya, Bengali, Assamese, Punjabi, English and Urdu

Section IB – 20 Languages:

French, Spanish, German, Nepali, Persian, Italian, Arabic, Arabic, Sindhi, Sanskrit, Kashmiri, Kankani, Bodo, Dogri, Maithili, Manipuri, Santhali, Tibetan, Japanese, Russian, Chinese

NB: A candidate can choose a maximum of any 3 languages from Section IA and Section IB taken together

Section III – General Tests

For any such undergraduate programme / programmes that are not mapped but being offered by Universities ; a General Test shall be used.



A candidate can choose a maximum of any 3 languages from Section IA and Section IB taken together. However, the third language chosen needs to be in lieu of 6th domain specific Subject chosen by the candidate – as applicable.

The maximum number of tests to be taken remain 9 only i.e., 2 Languages + 6 Domain Specific Subjects + 1 General Test

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3 Languages + 5 Domain Specific Subjects + 1 General Test

(Flexibility being provided to help a candidate apply for many Universities depending on their eligibility conditions)

The CUET entrance test will be held in two slots. The duration of the first slot is 45 to 195 minutes and the duration of CUET second slot is 45 to 225 minutes.

- For NEHU and its affiliating College there will be Offline Admission Counselling sessions only.



Important Instructions

- Candidates need to use a valid and unique email address of the applicant only as all communications are through registered email ID or SMS.
- No candidate will be able to change or edit the mobile number and email address on the application form later as these particulars are fixed.
- If the "Confirmation Page" is not generated within 24 hours, applicants need to raise a query in the query redressal system or send an email at cuet@nta.ac.in with their mobile number, application number, payment reference number, and proof of payment.
- <u>CUET 2022 admit card</u> will be uploaded by the conducting authority NTA on the official website (cuet.samarth.ac.in). Candidates need to check their respective admit card carefully for all particulars.
- **Candidates must bring the following documents on the day of examination at the test centre:**
 - Admit Card along with undertaking downloaded from the NTA website (a clear printout on A4 size paper)
 - Any photo ID proof (Aadhar Card, Driving Licence, Passport, Ration Card, PAN Card)
