The Khasi Hills Community REDD+ Project (KHCRP) implemented by ‘Ka Synjuk ki Hima Arliang Wah-Umiam Mawphlang Welfare Society’ under its Eco Tourism initiative strives for forest conservation and sustainable development of the communities within the project areas. Among many of initiatives taken up by the Synjuk, Tour Guide Training is one, and the Synjuk has been training local guides who are the youths of the communities from the project areas. After training for them for several months, the Synjuk also conducts assessment to evaluate the performance of these trained guides.

Therefore, the Synjuk has requested the faculty members of the Department of Tourism and Travel Management, Lady Keane College, Shillong to conduct an evaluation for these youths who are trained to be local guide for the attractions located in the project areas.

The faculty members of the Department of Tourism and Travel Management, Lady Keane College has conducted the evaluation on the job performance of these young local guides on the 12<sup>th</sup> July 2022 on the following criteria:
