Instructions for choosing subjects

- 1. The honours which you have already chosen will be your Major subject.
- 2. You have already chosen two elective subjects as per the old system. Now you have to choose only one Minor subject (elective subject) from the two which you have already choosen earlier. Meaning, you have to drop one elective subject under the present system.
- 3. New combination is given to the following Major Subjects.

Chemistry	Physics, Mathematics, Botany, Zoology, Biochemistry
Physics	Mathematics, Chemistry, BCA
Mathematics	Physics, Chemistry, Economics, BCA
Biochemistry	Chemistry, Zoology, Botany

Sociology	Economics, Education, History, Elective Language
Botany	Chemistry, Zoology, Biochemistry
Zoology	Chemistry, Botany, Biochemistry
BCA	Elective Language, Sociology, Economics, Physics,

Economics honours students can choose Maths as their minor subject provided the students had Maths in their higher secondary level.

- 4. The students will have to choose one Multidiciplanary subject from the given list. The subject taken in higher secondary level cannot be choosen as a multidiciplanary subject. Selection will be first come first serve. Students will get to choose their first, second, third,...... preferences.
- 5. The students will have to choose one Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) from the given list. Students will have to choose the course which they have already taken in the secondary and higher secondary level. For example Garo students will have to choose MIL Garo, Bengali students will have to choose MIL Bengali so on and so forth. Only those students who have not studied MIL earlier or whose MIL Subject is not included in the list can choose Alternative English. Screening of SSLC or HSSLC marksheets will be done by the NEP committee.
- 6. The students will have to choose one Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) from the given list. Selection will be done on first come first serve basis.
- 7. Environmental Studies as a Value Added Course (VAC) is compulsory for all students.
