#### 1. About Yuva Tourism Club, Lady Keane College, Shillong

The Ministry of Tourism in India aims to leverage its large youth population and demographic dividend by launching the "YUVA Tourism" campaign in 2022 as part of India@75 celebrations. The campaign's central initiative involves creating Tourism Clubs targeting schools, colleges, and working-age groups. The objectives of these clubs include educating young minds about India's diverse cultures and geography, fostering an appreciation for the educational value of travel and tourism, promoting responsible tourism practices, and training students as skilled tourist guides and hospitality volunteers. The clubs will also facilitate better coordination for study tours and student exchange programs, encouraging youth to explore the country's tourism opportunities early on.

The YUVA Tourism Club of Lady Keane College was inaugurated on 28th May, 2022, in the present of the Principal of the College Dr. D K B Mukhim, Faculty Coordinator Mr. Wanpynsuk Makri, Head of the Department of Tourism and Travel Management Miss. Montimon Diengdoh, Mr. Londoner Murphy Sohtun (Asst.prof) Department of Tourism and Travel Management, Mr. Sushant B Surong and Miss. Hakamelamphylla Mawroh (Asst.prof) Department of Tourism and Travel Management.

The proposed activities by these Tourism Clubs align with the government's vision and include organizing various competitions to foster creativity and engagement, integrating travel and tourism into the educational curriculum, and promoting sustainable and responsible tours in line with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). These tours will aim to minimize their impact on natural areas while providing opportunities for travelers to interact with local communities and understand their cultures and traditions. Furthermore, the clubs will encourage tourism during off-peak periods to boost local economies, combine tourism with various tournaments to engage students in exciting activities, and discover lesser-known destinations, providing travel itineraries and tourism potential information. The use of social media feedback will also play a role in marketing Indian destinations and attracting more visitors to explore the country's rich natural and cultural heritage.

#### **1.1. YUVA Tourism Club Members:**

#### 2. Event Details:

There are 40 Yuva Tourism Clubs including schools and colleges in Meghalaya, the competition was organized amongst all the YUVA Tourism Clubs members from different colleges in Meghalaya. The photography competition and exhibition program were being conducted as part of the world tourism day celebration 2023- by providing a platform to promote sustainable tourism and environmental consciousness among the YUVA Tourism Club Members from different colleges and university of the state. This initiative was taken to enhance the active participation of the club members and to raise awareness about the importance of green investment and sustainable practices in the tourism sectors.

## 2.1. Objective of the Competition:

The objective of the photography competition organized by the Indiatourism Shillong, Ministry of Tourism Government India, in association with YUVA Tourism Club, Lady Keane College Shillong, the competition was organized with an objective of highlighting on a sustainable getaway showcasing on creativity on how green investment positively impact tourism while emphasizing responsible and eco-friendly practices.

## 3. Event execution: Photography Competition and Exhibition

The competition was conducted on 5<sup>th</sup> September in the Seminar Hall of Lady Keane College at 12 Noon, where a total of five (5) YUVA Tourism Clubs of Different institutions from Shillong participated and attended at the exhibition programme.

The competition was conducted in two categories: - 1. DSLR Camera category and 2. Smartphone category. With each participant subjected to maximum of three (3) entries in each

category. A total number of fifty (50) entries were received, eight (8) entries for DSLR Camera and 42 entries for Smartphone category.

Three judges were invited to judge the competition that have good background on photography and are freelancer photographers which include Shri K.L Choudhary, an Associate Professor, Department of Botany, Lady Keane College, Shillong, Mrs. Veveane Sayo, Freelance Photographer and co-owner of Yolanda Productions House and Mr. Mebanshan Langstieh, an Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology, Lady Keane College, Shillong. The judging criteria were based on: -

- 1. Relevance to the theme (50%)
- 2. Creativity and Composition (30%)
- 3. Technical Excellence (20%)

The received total entries (50 nos) were judges on 4<sup>th</sup> September from 1 pm to 3 pm, by the renowned judges, and also exhibited in the seminar hall of Lady Keane College, Shillong on 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2023.
