The Department of Tourism and Travel Management, Lady Keane College, Shillong organised a local fieldtrip in the form of a local hike along David Scott Trail that covers the trail starting from Sohrarim Village to Mawphlang Village. The total distance of the hike is 16 kms which took 4 hours to complete it. Along with the teachers and the students, there were 3 local tour guides who guided the hike and explained the different elements and attractions that were important as heritage information along the trail especially in relation to the works and stories about David Scott (British Administrator posted in North-Eastern India during the early 1800s). The trail covers lush green meadows, open fields, rolling mountains, rushing streams, stone bridges and natural pools.

#### Objectives of the hike:

- To expose students on the local heritage resources of the state.
- To give students a glimpse of the history of British rule in India, particularly the Khasi Hills.
- To learnt the importance of historical and heritages resources for tourism.
- To give them awareness on legend tourism, historical, heritage and cultural tourism in the state.
- To observe skills of tour guiding and customer skills.

#### Learning outcomes of the programme:

- The students of the department learnt about the importance of heritage tourism.
- The students of the department became more aware of the history of the British Rule in India that expanded in the North Eastern Region particularly in the Khasi Hills of Meghalaya.
- The students of the department learnt about the different elements and attractions along the David Scott Trail which are important for their knowledge and information.
- The students of the department learnt about the various stories and legends behind every natural resource stone during the heritage hike.
- Overall, the students of the department learnt about the importance of the knowledge of the heritage in the area and also about the conservation of the same.
