## REPORT ON FINANCIAL LITERACY CAMP

The Financial Literacy Camp organized by the Reserve Bank of India in collaboration with the Students Cell was held on the 29<sup>th</sup> of April, 2022 at 12:00 pm in the College Seminar Room. There were two sessions, the first session was for the students, which was represented by the B Sc sixth semester students and the second session was for the teachers. The resource person explained about the limits of transactions that can be done with each mode of online payments and also enlightened the participants about UPI 123 a type of online payment that can be used on a feature phone and which has become a very popular mode of payment in Rural areas. The participants were also given valuable information on the steps to report a fraud in online transactions. The resource person also explained about the different types of online frauds like Phishing links, vishing calls, Juice jecking and also alerted the participants to never use free WiFi for any financial transactions.

The talk was followed by a quiz for all participants where questions were asked based on the information provided. Participants were awarded a prize for giving the right answer.

The RBI was also very generous to donate sports equipments to the Students Cell for the use of students which included a football, a basketball, a volley ball net, a volleyball, a pump. The program ended with the distribution of light refreshments to all participants.
