REPORT ON THE OBSERVATION OF INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS DAY DECEMBER 10, 2022

The Lady Keane College Nodal Centre for Human Rights (LKCNCHR), as per its Executive Board meeting held on December 1, 2022, decided to observe the upcoming 75th International Human Rights Day on December 10, 2022.

The annual event was observed on International Human Rights Day 2022 in the Seminar Hall. Prof. T. T. Haokip, Department of Political Science, North Eastern Hill University, was the guest speaker at the event. The program began with a welcome address from the principal of Lady Keane College, Prof. Dr. D. K. B. Mukhim.


The program was scheduled for 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. However, due to an inadvertent delay from the guest speaker, it began at 11:00 a.m. and ended at 12:50 p.m. The guest speaker expounded on the theme "Dignity, Freedom, and Justice for All". He highlighted the importance of dignity, freedom, and justice. He pointed out that even though dignity, freedom, and justice are the inherent rights and values of every human being, regardless of human race, ethnicity, gender, sexuality, or any other characteristic, they still remain elusive as systemic injustices, and the denial of freedom and dignity persists despite the rights declared 75 years ago.

Altogether, there were 64 student participants from different disciplines in both the arts and science streams. The program was also attended by faculty members from other departments, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), and members of the Nodal Centre.

The program was successfully observed with the active support of the internal quality assurance cell of the college. The program was hosted by Ms. Wanda Lyngdoh, department of Zoology, and the program ended with a vote of thanks proposed by Ms. Beena Sawkmei, a member of the Nodal Centre and a faculty member from the department of sociology.
