Dr. David Livingstone Smith, Professor of Philosophy at the University of New England was the keynote speaker. The other speakers included Professor S. I. Keethaponcalan, Salisbury University, Maryland, USA. who spoke on the theme ‘Peace: Theory, Practice and Science’ and Professor Cynthia Freeland, Professor Emeritus, University of Houston, USA. who talked on ‘Fighting racism with Art’. There was a discussion on the recently released book entitled ‘Landscapes of Society and Culture’ authored by Meera Chakravorty (Authors Group Publication, New Delhi ,2022).
